To provide the network services required for its schools and administrative offices, the District will maintain strict control of both its Wide Area Network (WAN) and Local Area Network (LAN) to include bandwidth utilization and restrictions on priority, protocol, and data. This control will ensure proper network performance, security, and the availability of resources throughout the district's infrastructure.

Authorization and management of all devices and connections to the network shall be at the direction of the Director of Technology or Superintendent's Designee. No unauthorized device may be connected to any District network.
